	• PR announced the purpose of the session, which was to provide the Board with an update of the Skills Strategy and its Action plan and to discuss the	



	<ul> <li>possibility of aligning the Strategy with Digital Board, ensuring a committed joint approach.</li> <li>PR and GM talked the Board through their presentation, covering the background, the goals, strategic approach and deliverables.</li> <li>The Board discussed the Strategy; the following observations and suggestions were made: <ul> <li>✓ Understanding the workforce skills gap requires a good understanding of employers needs on the Island.</li> <li>✓ Al's potential is going to transform the skill requirements on the island – there is the need to assess roles that are bound to arise in the long-term and roles that will no longer be required, supporting employers where appropriate to understand the implications of this disruptive technology.</li> <li>✓ There is a need to target specific markets such as South Africa and Hong Kong to attract diverse talent to help build a more skilled workforce on the island.</li> <li>✓ Digital Isle of Man is engaged with AI Singapore who have already considered the workforce impact of AI within their economy and DIOM can facilitate a discussion if this is considered beneficial.</li> <li>✓ There is a need to work with the wider Government to tackle immigration and travel barriers.</li> <li>✓ The Board understands the importance of Government, Industry and Education working together in putting a message across younger generation about opportunities present on the island. Focusing on the needs of the individual to encourage uptake and engagement would be beneficial.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	PR
	<ul> <li>There is a need for a commitment to disseminate information to primary and secondary school teachers about digital roles and job opportunities.</li> <li>The "One Stop Shop" concept to centralise information and resources for various sectors and career paths is essential.</li> <li>It is important to be able to track numbers of younger individuals leaving and coming back in a tax generating capacity and developing a model for keeping in touch with school leavers.</li> <li>It is important to create potential incentives schemes for returners possessing certain skills.</li> <li>A focus on career planning earlier in the education cycle would enhance job readiness and support DESC in planning and resourcing.</li> <li>RO leads skills development within the DIOM; we need to develop a clear understanding of how DIOM interact with the skills board moving forward.
